This is where your DIAMOND needs to sparkle bright! The judges get to see who you are and what you are made of! Put your smile and shine on to make them LOVE who you are.

- Your interview goals i
- s where you share your personality.
- Speak from your heart!
- Interview is 30% of each contestant score. The score will range from 15-30 points. The required attire is a dress or jumpsuit. No suits or jeans allowed for all age division. Makeup should be like everyday makeup and not overbearing – simple, clean & fresh.
- Timing with each judge is Pre-Teen/Jr. Teen 3 minutes and Teen/Miss is 5 minutes.
- Interview winners will be announced in each age division on final night of competition.



HIGH FASHION

SHOW THEM WHAT YOU'RE MADE OF!!

High Fashion is Chic/Red Carpet Ready! Stepping out on the Red Carpet is your diamond glow.

Each contestant will model an outfit of choose and the fashion that will make them sparkle. The attire that is allowed in this phase of competition is your own sense of style. You may accessorize, but no umbrellas, handbags, or bags. You can do such things as flower in your hair, fur hat, flowers on clothing.

This phrase of competition is worth 30%. Scoring will range from 15-30 points for each judge

High Fashion winner will be announced in each age division on final night of competition.

EVENING GOWN

The elegance of beauty!!

Director's Note – Walking out on the stage I knew that evening gown had to be where I showed grace and stage presence. My choice of an evening gown was defined by my choice of elegance and what I felt the judges would love.

- Make sure that you can walk comfortably in your dress and heels
- Make sure that your gown fits you to perfection
- Make sure you "sparkle" for the judges
- Make sure your hair style flatters you and the style of your dress
- Evening gown is worth 30% of each contestant's total score

OTHER AREAS OF COMPETITION

ON STAGE QUESTION – ONLY THE TOP 5 WILL HAVE A FINAL ON STAGE QUESTION WHICH IS WORTH 5%. WINNERS IN EACH AGE DIVISION WILL BE SELECTED BY THE TOTAL WEIGHTED POINTS COLLECTED THROUGHOUT THE PRELIM AND FINAL COMPETITION.

RESUME – EACH CONTESTANT WILL RECEIVE 5% WHICH IS 5 POINTS OF THEIR OVERALL SCORE BY COMPLETING A RESUME AND RETURNING IT ON TIME. THIS INFORMATION IS LOCATED ON THE NATIONAL WEBSITE WITH INSTRUCTIONS. POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED IF THE RESUME IS NOT TURNED INTO THE NATIONAL OFFICE BEFORE THE PAGEANT. CONTESTANTS WILL NOT RECEIVE THE 5 POINTS FOR THIS PHASE OF COMPETITION.

THE PHOTOGENIC COMPETITION IS JUDGED BY THE OPTIONAL JUDGES ONLY. CONTESTANTS CAN SUBMIT UP TO (4) PICTURES. JUDGES WILL CONSIDER THE PHOTOGENIC QUALITY AND CLARITY OF THE PHOTO. SCORING IS BASED ON 10-25 POINTS PER JUDGE FOR A POSSIBLE TOTAL OF 75 POINTS. MAKE SURE THAT YOUR PICTURES ARE AGE APPROPRIATE. THERE WILL BE ONE PHOTOGENIC WINNER PER AGE DIVISION. **PRICE: \$50.00 (EACH) (LIMIT 4)**







TOP MODEL

THE TOP MODEL COMPETITION IS JUDGED BY THE OPTIONAL JUDGES ONLY. CONTESTANTS ARE AUTOMATICALLY ENTERED INTO THE TOP MODEL COMPETITION WHEN THEY SUBMIT 4 PHOTOS IN THE PHOTOGENIC COMPETITION. SCORING IS BASED ON 10-25 POINTS FOR A POSSIBLE TOTAL OF 75 POINTS. THEN THE SCORE FOR ALL 4 PHOTOS WILL BE COMBINED TO FIND AN OVERALL POSSIBLE SCORE OF 400. THERE WILL BE ONE WINNER FOR PRE-TEEN/JUNIOR TEEN AND ONE WINNER FOR TEEN/MISS. **PRICE: NO ADDITIONAL COST**



TALENT

THE TALENT COMPETITION IS AN INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE. SCORING IS BASED ON TECHNIQUE AND EXECUTION, COSTUMING, GRACE, CONNECTION TO THE AUDIENCE, AND PRESENTATION. THE TIME LIMIT IS 1 MINUTE. JUDGES SCORING IS FROM 10-25 POINTS IN EACH CATEGORY. TOTAL POSSIBLE POINTS AWARDED IS 75 POINTS. FULL MAKE UP IS ALLOWED IN THIS COMPETITION. (SOME TALENT COMPETITIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED, SO PLEASE MESSAGE THE NATIONAL OFFICE BEFORE SIGNING UP.)

Traveling is another passion, allowing me to explore new places and cultures.


I have two older sisters, an older brother, and two nieces who mean the world to me.

Your \$320 which pays for your crown, sash & state title must be paid in-order to receive the password under Official Contestant Forms ON WEBSITE.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Please read ALL rules below before calling with questions. Most questions will be answered below.

- 1. Contestants must be a legal resident of which state they live in and must compete her age division on day of the pageant.
- 2. Deadline is June 30, 2023, by Midnight. Those who turn in their form and fees by this deadline will receive a free admission to Miss Diamond National USA Scholarship Pageant. (FULL PAYMENT ONLY)

Late entries will not be accepted! All forms and fees may be mailed, or hand delivered to the Miss Diamond National USA office. If you are mailing your forms, please allow plenty of time for it to arrive. The Miss Diamond National USA Scholarship Pageant is not responsible for entry forms that may be lost or delayed in transit by shipping method.

- 3. Contestants are required to be on time for check-in and the pageant. We will start on time for all age groups to allow a smooth and time efficient pageant.
- 4. ATTIRE and DRESSING ROOMS: All youth contestants will compete in pageant dress (long or short). There is a limited amount of space in the dressing room so please come stage ready with hair and makeup. Once you have changed into your pageant dress, please do not hang out in the dressing room! No more than one FEMALE guest is allowed in the dressing room with the contestant. If a father is chaperoning his daughter, they must use the family restroom in the facility.
- 5. Because of stage lighting, makeup is allowed for the young ladies if it is age appropriate and used with discretion. (Light mascara, powder blush, lip gloss or light lip stick)
- 6. NO CAMERAS, VIDEO CAMERAS, or CELL PHONE CAMERAS allowed in the building during competition. All stage and crowning shots will be available for purchase from PHOTOGRAPHER. Please see the photographer during registration.
- 7. PHOTOGENIC: All age divisions can participate in the optional photogenic contest within each age group. Photos is due the day of the pageant. Photos can be natural or glitz (lightly retouched by your photographer is acceptable). Photo should be a 5x7 or 8 x 11, color or black and white. To participate in the photogenic competition, please include the additional fee. FOUR PHOTO IS ACCEPTABLE PER CONTESTANT! Photos will be available for pickup after the pageant at the registration table. The pageant is not responsible for left photos. Please label the back of photo with name and age.
- 8. OPTIONAL DIVISION AWARDS: Prettiest Eyes, Prettiest Smile, Prettiest Hair, Best Dressed, Most Beautiful. These awards are judged during final line up of contestants in evening gown. These divisions are optional and have no bearing on the outcome of the winners.
- 9. In each division, we will award Queen, 1st runner up, 2nd runner up, 3rd runner up and 4th runner up, if that division has that number of contestants.
- 10. JUDGING: Judges will be looking for facial beauty, personality, stage presence, confidence, poise, and overall appearance. The pageant will choose qualified and impartial judges and their names may or may not be released before the pageant.
- 11. Score sheets will NOT be given out or made available at any time. All decisions of the judges are final.
- 12. Good conduct and sportsmanship are always expected during the pageant and throughout the reign of each winner. Bad sportsmanship from a contestant, family member, or supporter will result in disqualification and/or relinquishing of that title as well as being banned from all future pageants at the Miss Diamond National USA Scholarship Pageant. Unbecoming conduct and bad language will NOT be tolerated.
- 13. Contestants in divisions 1-3 must be accompanied onstage by a chaperone. Ages 3-4 may have a chaperone onstage without any deduction of points. Contestant must compete age the day of the pageant.
- 14. The Miss Diamond National USA Scholarship Pageant is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property. Please treat the facility with the utmost respect and clean up after yourself when the competition is over. Those leaving behind excessive trash or mess may be disqualified from future events.
- 15. The State Director and/or National Pageant Management reserve the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with any incident surrounding the contest, and the right to amend or add to these rules as their judgment may determine. Any contestant who fails to abide by any of the above rules can be disqualified from the competition by the State Director.
